Napoleon's Rise and Fall

- 1798 Leads an expedition to Egypt. It's a failure but is able to keep it hid with tight censorship.
- 1799 Overthrows the Directory in a Coup. Creates the Consulate, with 3 consuls (of course he was First Consul).
- 1801 Declared Emperor (puts crown on own head)
- 1801 The Concordat makes peace with the Catholic Church.
- 1804-1812 Battles annexing the Netherlands, Belgium, and parts of Italy and Germany.
 - 1805 Battle of Trafalgar is a defeat for the French Navy. Napoleon then implements the Continental System to "bring England in line" through trade restrictions.
 - 1805 Battle of Austerlitz is a defeat for Austria
 - 1809 Battle of Wagram is a defeat for Austria, resulting in land given to Napoleon.

Throughout, Spain and Austria battle France with Guerilla Warfare Tactics

1812 - Napoleon invades Russia with 600,000+ soldiers, and get as far as Moscow by September. The Russians use *Scorched Earth Policy*. The retreating French lose all but about 20,000 soldiers.

During this time Napoleon abolished the Holy Roman Empire and put a 38-member confederation in its place. Napoleon also puts friends and family in power throughout his empire... furthering resentment..,

- 1813 Defeated at Leipzig against Russia, Austria, Britain, and Prussia.
- 1814 Napoleon steps down and is banned to Elbe Island. Louis XVIII is restored. Napoleon escapes... the king flees...
- 1815 Napoleon reigns for 100 days
- 1815 June 18 Napoleon is defeated at Waterloo and exiled to St. Helena.
- 1821 Napoleon dies
